OUTCOMES

Literacy Action's success metrics for each program include student persistence for program completion and academic progress, which we track for every 40-60 hours of instruction. Equally important as adult learners' academic progress is the growth in their self-confidence. Students complete self-efficacy surveys at the end of each program to evaluate confidence to complete daily tasks and improvement in self-sufficiency.

73% of students made an academic gain

62% of respondents feel more independent

88% feel their job performance has improved

76% are more confident that they can support their children or grandchildren's learning

65% of GED program participants passed all four tests






RACE




AGE
